July Schedule Updates

We will be going to the Lincoln Playground from 8:30 to 9:30 daily, unless there is another activity planned (water days) or the weather does not permit it. Please, if you plan on dropping off after we have left the building, bring them to the Lincoln Elementary playground. You can drop them off/ sign them in at the Yellow Poles or at the parking lot in the front of the building. Thursdays we will have Keep Kids Safe program at 9:30, meaning we will be leaving for Lincoln by 8:30 and returning by 9:20. On Library Fridays, we will be going to the Library immediately following our time at Lincoln. Due to Keep Kids Safe and Graduation practices being on Thursdays, we will be canceling Show and Tell until after Graduation. We will have one last one for the month on June 9.

Graduation

On Friday August 7, 2026 @ 5:45pm we will have our graduation ceremony located in the church sanctuary. Parents can arrive as early as 5:15 and find their seats. Your child will need to stay with you until staff come to collect them for graduation. Each child will be receiving a matching shirt to wear for the ceremony that they will be able to keep after. We will also provide a Cap for the ceremony that we will be collecting after. Light refreshments will be available after the ceremony in the cafeteria (we will have a sign up sheet available in the coming weeks).

Reminders

- **Filled Water Bottles are needed Daily at drop off** (please fill them in the morning if you leave them here)
- **Closed toe shoes and active play appropriate clothing worn to school daily** (we will be going to a playground daily)
- Please leave a sweater in their cubby for when they get cold
- Check the bins in bathroom for weather appropriate clothing and proper sizes
- All children must use the bathroom before entering our classroom (we do not have easy access to one)
- **Toys: please leave at home unless it is for show and tell.** These are causing issues when passing them in the hall.

Graduation Practice

We have been practicing the songs for a few months, but we will start to practice the entire run threw of the graduation starting the last two weeks of July (primarily on Tuesday and Thursday so our part timers catch one practice a week at least). Some of our friends that disenrolled for the summer will come back and visit for practice. We can't wait to see everyone together again.
